"The Spirit of the LORD God is upon me (us), because the LORD has anointed me (us) to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent me (us) to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they (people of Peru) may be called tress of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified."

He is calling us by His Spirit, to plant those seeds that will bring freedom, truth, and light, to the people of Peru, who are living a life without hope, without true meaning of unconditional love. We are called to display His splendor so that they will know who Jesus is and be transformed by His Spirit so that their names can be written in the Book of Life!
